- If you have a dog with you, this is a great opportunity to give them a run around off the lead in the Dog Exercising Area
- Walk up the hill with the dog exercising area on your left and at the top of the hill go straight across onto the gravel track, past the camping pitches and on for 125 metres until you see the "Bee Bank" on your right
- Visit the Bee Bank and see what species of bee, butterfly and wildflowers you can identify at certain times of year
- Follow the path past the Premier Camping Pods on your right and past the children's adventure play area
- Go through the fenced walkway past the gravel pitches and turn left at the road
- Follow the road around to the right and walk straight on towards the Holiday Home Owner's Caravans
- In the fenced area in front of the Caravan Holiday Homes, you will see the "Bug Hotel," otherwise known as "Bugingham Palace."
- Go straight on into the Caravan area of the park and follow the road around until you reach a gravel track on the left and walk down to the blue clad building

Detour 2

- Continue past the blue clad building and down
 the steps
- Go through the gate at the bottom of the slope, turn right and then left and continue along the footpath for 200 metres towards the village of Eype
- At the gate, go over the stile, past the car parking and turn right at the footpath
- Follow the path for 300 metres until you reach the stile out onto the lane and turn right
- Walk along the lane past the church to the next turning on your right and go up the pathway
- Follow the path for 275 metres until you reach the park driveway and turn right
- Turn left at the car park, then right into the beer garden for Martin's Bar & Restaurant
- From the blue clad building, turn around and go left at the road
- Follow the road and pass the Park Reception and Park Shop where you started on your left
- Turn right at the car park and then right again into the beer garden for Martin's Bar & Restaurant

CONGRATULATIONS The Nature Trail is complete!

While you are following the trail, make sure you are keeping an eye out for the letter signs & noting them down



Route Guidance

Leaving the Park Shop, turn left and left again past the Park Reception and down the driveway After 100 metres, turn right down the gravel track After 150 metres, turn left and go through the gate Go down through the first and second fields and follow the track around to the left to Mower's Mead Wildlife Lake

Detour 1

- Continue along the track then onto the concrete road Go through the kissing gate and turn right before the underpass and go up the steps
- Follow the footpath for 220 metres until you reach a clearing. Go straight ahead and through the gate immediately on your right
- Go across the wooden bridge, through the gate, across the second wooden bridge and over the stile into the field
- Follow the right hand edge of this field around to the gate in the top corner and go through into the next field
- Follow the left hand edge of this field and go through the gate into the next field
- If you are not taking the detour, turn around and go back through the gate and follow the left hand edge of the field to the top corner
- Go through the wooden gate, around to the right, over the stile and take a left onto the path through the trees
- Follow the path for 200 metres before veering up the slope on your right and follow the path in the field for a further 200 metres towards West Bay
- Go through the gate and turn right. Follow the path uphill to the metal gate and go over the wooden stile Follow the right hand edge of the field to the top corner and go through the kissing gate, joining the South West Coast Path
- Follow the Coast Path for 475 metres with the park on your right hand side. You should be able to pick out the clifftop peak of Thorncombe Beacon, the "Broadchurch Hut" and Colmer's HIII from this view Follow the Coast Path down the hill towards Eype Beach and turn right at the bench, going through the kissing gate in the trees
